

Chateau Fontaine



If God is in the details, Chateau Fontaine is as close to heaven as some of us might come on earth. It's because of his amazing grace Grace Farm was named.

The center of a sprawling 40-acre plantation in the North Carolina Piedmont, Chateau Fontaine is a study in understated elegance and Southern civility. Set lightly on the land amid sheltering oaks and towering magnolias, the stately two-story brick Colonial turned Bed and Breakfast bears the hallmarks of a well-loved home.

Through the gazebo, an elegant hand-carved fountain makes a gracious welcome at the approach.

From its top, water spills over a stone pineapple - long a symbol of hospitality - into cascading tiers below.

Braced by imposing white columns that span the height of the facade, heavy French doors framed in leaded cut glass usher you in. Once inside, you'll find each of Chateau Fontaine's rooms as meticulously furnished and cared for as the next. In keeping with the inn-keeper's French provence, the palate is very French-Provincial. Formal, yet comfortable and unpretentious, living and dining areas are tastefully appointed and open to all guests. Four private guest rooms are suitably decorated in fabrics and finishes that give a modish nod to the look that was in fashion at the turn of the century, each with its own personality and style.

A sun-dappled veranda, with its timeless white rattan groupings and classic wooden porch swing, makes a comfy spot for an afternoon respite. From this vantage point, you can immerse yourself in soothing tranquility with the relaxing lull of the gurgling fountain and glorious views of the plentiful gardens.

The surrounding lands, which together with Chateau Fontaine were once a 200-acre working tobacco farm, now serve as the pastoral grounds for the Egyptian Arabians of Grace Farm. The majestic thoroughbreds make a picture as they roam freely and unbridled to complete the idyllic effect. Just down the way there's a fully stocked,

three-and-a-half-acre recreational lake that's a great place to drop a line or launch a canoe.

A fully furnished covered pavilion, ensconced in magnolias, maples, and oaks, features a wood-burning stone fireplace, chandeliers, granite countertops, and coordinating wicker, is an ideal venue for weddings, rehearsals, receptions, and other such celebrated occasions at an additional fee.
